Suggestions for AIDS Walk and Run Participants

Before the Event

1. **Set a personal fundraising goal.**
2. **Set up your personal online donation page.**
3. **Fundraise!**

4. **Collect the money in advance.**

Collect your pledges in advance. Ask your sponsors to give you their donation when they pledge. This will help you avoid making a second trip to collect the contributions. Checks should be made payable to "AIDS Walk Colorado" or simply "AWC". Donor's cancelled checks will be their receipts.

Matching Gifts Can Easily Double Your Money

You may be able to double your contributions to AIDS Walk Colorado! Ask those who sponsor you if their company has a matching gift program. Hundreds of companies match the donation of their employees. Also check with your employer to see if they will match your donation and/or the money you raise. Please bring complete Matching Gift Forms with you to Registration on the morning of the event or on the pre-event collection day.
